

PROPER SETUP AND OPERATION OF YOUR TIMEWORKS CLOCK

Timeworks is proud of the high quality standards we use to design and produce our products. To ensure trouble-free operation of your Timeworks Clock, follow the simple guidelines below.

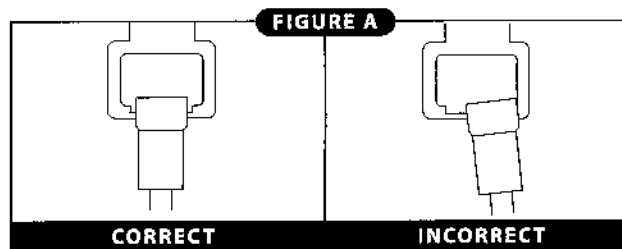
All Models

1. Make sure that you have installed a fresh battery in the direction indicated on the movement.
2. Set time by turning knob on back of movement or by moving the minute hand only until the correct time is indicated on the clock. *Do not manually move the hour hand - this may damage the clock movement.*

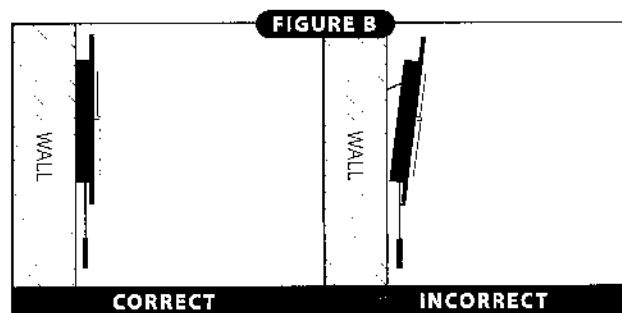
Pendulum Models

To ensure that the pendulum swings correctly, these steps must be followed.

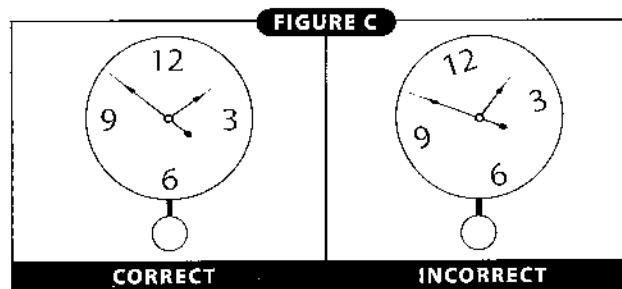
3. Hook on pendulum must be correctly positioned in center of hanger on back of movement (Fig. A)



4. Clock must rest flat against the wall (Fig. B)
Note: If necessary, bend nail upwards slightly, or, if using a screw, head of screw should be closer to the wall.



5. Clock must be positioned vertically on the wall, so that the pendulum hangs directly below 6 o'clock. (Fig. C)



6. Give pendulum a gentle push to get it started.

Additional Troubleshooting

If the pendulum still does not swing, ensure that pendulum movement on rear of clock has not shifted. (Fig. D)

- If it has, gently twist the clock movement back into a vertical position (it may have shifted during shipping and handling).
